Glynn County Pantry Program and Sea Island

Building on the partnership between Sea Island and America's Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia, Sea Island is excited to sponsor the Glynn County School Pantry Program. The program provides take-home meals for all public elementary, middle, high, and specialty schools in the county.

Throughout Glynn County, there are 19 distribution locations for the pantry program. At each location, children, parents, and staff members may pick-up a backpack as often as they need. Volunteers fill each backpack with one evening meal that can feed up to four people, along with snacks, and breakfast items. Throughout the 2021 - 2022 school year, which runs September through April, the program offered an estimated 8,000 meals to those experiencing food insecurity within Glynn County.

Together, we are working to help raise awareness for the Glynn County School Pantry Program within our local communities. One of our biggest areas of opportunity for the program is education and making sure that those in need know there are resources available and how to access them. Teachers, principals, guidance counselors, and social workers can refer students and families to the program.

Soon, the Brunswick branch of America's Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia will be able to cook and provide hot meals from its new facility. This will be especially crucial over the summer months, as children are on break and without access to food assistance programs at their schools.

We know that childhood hunger continues to be a concerning issue in Coastal Georgia. But with the continued support of our community, we are confident that it's an issue that can be solved— together.
