Sea Island and Saved By Grace

Over the past year and a half, Sea Island has cultivated a close relationship with ‘Saved By Grace,’ a local non-profit that provides basic necessities for the unsheltered in the community, and its co-founder Donna Howard. Among its many services, Saved By Grace houses up to fourteen men who are working to transition out of homelessness.

“We want them to know they’re a person, they have value,” Howard said. “We feel like a major part of what we do is restore their hope.”

David Cutia, Facilities Manager at Sea Island, visits Saved by Grace every week and conducts interviews with each of its residents.

“Not only are we looking to give these men an opportunity for a fulfilling career, but we are also helping them cast a greater vision for their lives,” says Cutia. “Our goal is to start these men on the path to receive technical training and certification opportunities. That could give them the power to change their lives.”

Currently, Cutia has five Saved By Grace residents who work alongside him in his department. Although, Cutia says their journey is so much more than a job. “It is inspiring to see the hope they have for a better future and to be a part of that transformation is an incredible experience.”

Sea Island also provides transportation for these men, to and from work, which has been instrumental for their success. “In times where transportation arrangements were not possible, I have personally picked them up,” states Cutia. “The gratitude that pours from their hearts is immeasurable.”
