Sea Island and the St. Simons Land Trust

The St. Simons Land Trust is vital to our community in many ways. Their mission is to protect the natural and scenic character of the area and enhance the quality of life for present and future generations. The Land Trust's 'Pennies for Preservation' initiative is a voluntary 1% giving program in which businesses help raise funds to conserve greenspaces, trails, wildlife, important habitat, and tree canopies throughout St. Simons Island.

In 2001, Sea Island became a founding member of 'Pennies for Preservation' - well before the program officially launched in 2017. For over twenty years, Sea Island has instituted a voluntary \$2/night donation that guests may opt in to during a stay at The Cloister or The Lodge. These dollars go directly to the St. Simons Land Trust and assists them in their efforts to live out their mission.
